**1960 to 1972**

Prior to 1973, Canada did not independently participate in the Jessup as its own country; however, Canadians were participants on various Jessup teams at American law schools, and Canadian law schools occasionally participated representing themselves. Beginning in 1973, Canada began holding National Division Qualifying Tournaments to determine the Canadian law school(s) which would represent Canada at the International Rounds.
